Environmentally Speaking

Lumber from the Pacific Northwest and British Columbia, including Western Red Cedar, is one of the world's greatest renewable resources. Every year, millions of new trees are planted on private forest lands, about five new trees for each one harvested. When logs arrive at a lumber mill, they are evaluated for maximum use and minimum waste with virtually every part of the log being utilized. The very best wood is cut and used for fencing boards, framing members and posts. Bark, chips and even sawdust are used for secondary products. Western Red Cedar is a renewable resource that is also recyclable!

We order the vast majority of our wood directly from lumber mills insuring that our customers receive only the highest quality materials available. Our professional staff will assist you with the layout and design of your project, making helpful suggestions along the way to provide solutions for your fencing wants & needs. Posts

Rough sawn Western Red Cedar posts are available with a Flat Top, Bevel Top, Gothic Top or French Gothic Top design. Adding Dado cuts or Decorative Post Caps will enhance the appearance of your new fence and can be a strong statement of your personality. All posts are set in concrete footings to insure the stability of your fence against constant wind forces. Standard post spacing for fences up to 6' high is 8' on center, but will vary slightly to adapt to the layout of each project.

Stringers

For superior strength, we use true rough sawn Western Red Cedar stringers for the framing members in the construction of your fence. Most applications require two stringers between each post. We install our stringers so they are nailed in a vertical position. This design helps reduce sagging between posts due to the weight of the boards.


Boards

We use only the highest quality boards available that have a great appearance on both sides, are resistant to rot, warping, splitting and have tight knots. For most applications, we use full dimension 4" or 6" wide rough sawn boards. Aluminum nails are used to secure the fence boards to stringers and will insure the lasting beauty of your fence without rust stains or streaks.
